

2018 APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP SACRAMENTO MINERAL SOCIETY, INC.

◇ **MEMBERSHIP DUES:** The dues period of the Society are January 1st – December 31st.

Dues are as follows:

◇ EVERY member (except minors or those with health issues passed by the board) **MUST** donate a minimum of 8 work hours for one (or more) of our main public events, meeting the expectations of that shift. Otherwise they can elect to pay an additional \$30 fee instead (due by Oct. 31st). We NEED members to help at our events or we will NOT survive, and this is an expected part of being a member.

Initial to acknowledge.

For New Members ... (with 2 Basic Cabochon Classes included OR orientation)

- ◇ **Single Adult Membership:** \$45 dollars for the first year, with the option to choose an engraved badge (\$8.00) or a printed badge (free).
- ◇ **Each Additional Adult (living at the same address):** \$37 for the first year (with the same badge options as noted above).
- ◇ **Junior Membership:** Junior Members (8-17 yrs.) same price as renewing Junior Membership (with classes being paid separately as they need/want to take them). The junior member must be sponsored and supervised by an adult member.

For Renewing Members ...

- ◇ **Single Adult Membership:** \$25 dollars a year, with the option to choose an engraved badge (\$8.00) or a printed badge (free).
- ◇ **Each Additional Adult (living at the same address):** \$17 for the first year (with the same badge options as noted above).
- ◇ **Junior Membership:** Junior Members (8-17 yrs.) must pay the annual fee for CFMS dues & insurance (\$10.00), with the option to choose an engraved badge (\$8.00 each) or printed badge (free). The junior member must be sponsored and supervised by an adult member.

Prorate breakdown: From October 1st - remaining membership for that year will be \$9 IF the next year's membership is paid in full.
